PSHE Curriculum Pathway Spring Term 1 2023



Key Stage 3 focus this term: <u>Respectful Relationships</u>

- Different types of families
- Positive relationships in the home
- Reducing homelessness
- Conflict and it's causes in different contexts
- Conflict resolution strategies
- Managing relationship and family changes

Key Stage 4 & 5 focus this term: *Healthy Relationships*

- Relationship abuse
- Consent
- Sharing sexual images
- Harassment and stalking
- Reducing inappropriate behaviours

Students will participate in a weekly discrete PSHE lesson based on their key stage topic.

However, PSHE threads through our curriculum at The Haven and there are opportunities to engage in PSHE throughout the week. in This could take the form of assemblies, form times, social times, keyworker sessions and other curriculum areas. For example; when problem solving using money and budgeting in maths, debating political issues in English or learning about cultures around the world in Geography.
