

PSHE Curriculum Pathway Summer Term 1 2023



Key Stage 3, 4 and 5 focus this term: Living in the Wider World

Gaming and Gambling

Key Stage 3:

Games- what when and how? What are the risks? Esports- the Gaming Industry. The blurred lines. Probability and Luck. Gaming: The good, the bad and the ugly.

Key Stage 4:

Gambling advertising and marketing. Safeguarding. Gambling- motivation and risk. Why do young people gamble? Gambling related harm. Money and debt. Gambling trends.

Key Stage 5:

Gaming and Gambling- bias and ethics. Safeguarding. Finances, debt and support. Mental Health when gaming and gambling. Esports and professional gaming. Loot boxes.

Students will participate in a weekly discrete PSHE lesson based on their key stage topic.

However, PSHE threads through our curriculum at The Haven and there are opportunities to engage in PSHE throughout the week. This could take the form of assemblies, form times, social times, keyworker sessions and other curriculum areas. For example; when problem solving using money and budgeting in maths, debating political issues in English or learning about cultures around the world in Geography.

Special days in religious calendars as well as any current affairs in the news will also be discussed and learnt about as they arise.
